Congratulations and thank you for your interest in becoming the next Ohio Rural Heritage Queen. You have already taken the first step by entering the pageant.

Contestants must be between the ages of 15 and 20 years old.

This is our 10th Year Anniversary, so the theme is RED, WHITE, BLUE and YOU!

Important Dates:

- Saturday, Aug. 10, 2024 Application must be received by pageant organizer.
- Tuesday, Aug. 20 at 6:30 PM Stage familiarity. Can come and practice your walk and receive any extra feedback. (Not Mandatory)
- Wednesday, Aug. 21 at 6:30 PM There will be a MANDATORY rehearsal on the main stage (located on the riverfront in Ripley, Ohio) to familiarize candidates with the stage, learn the choreography (simple) and finalize any lineups, positions etc.
- Thursday, Aug. 22 at 3 PM Tentatively- Judges Interview with Candidates begins. We will schedule a time for you.
- Thursday, Aug. 22 at 7 PM The pageant will take place on the main stage on the riverfront in Ripley, Ohio.
- **Friday, Aug. 23 at 6 PM** All candidates are encouraged to ride in the parade. The Queen will be required to ride in the parade.

All pageant applicants will be judged on this criteria:

- ★ 1 A 10 minute face to face interview with the judges. (Location to be announced)
- ★ 2 Contestants will come out in outfit of choice that must be Red, White and Blue themed and reflects your individual style.
- ★ 3 Evening Gown Competition. Must be long and appropriate.
- ★ 4 Response to a question asked and answered while candidate is on stage. This question will be based on information provided within each candidate's application so please keep this in mind when completing your application.
- ★ 5- Most Photogenic. Must Submit two photos; a full body and a head shot.

Queen and First Runner-Up/ Second Runner-Up Requirements

The winner of the pageant will receive the title of "Ohio Rural Heritage Queen". The chosen queen will be required to participate in the remainder of the festival activities. She will also be required to attend two fundraising events throughout the year held locally to raise money for the Ohio Rural Heritage Association. The Queen will also be required to participate in at least three local parades as well as the Brown County fair parade.

A first runner up will also be selected and should the original queen not be able to fulfill her duties the first runner up will take her place. There will be a crown, sash and monetary award given to the chosen Queen as well as a sash and monetary award for her runner up. The selected Queen must exhibit conduct throughout the year appropriate of someone representing the Ohio Rural Heritage Festival. If at anytime it is determined that the conduct is questionable, the first runner up will take the place of the current Queen.

Please complete the application on the next two pages and return it along with your two photos no larger than a 4" x 6". Your packet must be received by the pageant organizer on or before August 10th, 2024.
